# Welcome

The proceeds from this evening's concert are being divided between the Dorset Youth Marching Band and my four Mayoral Charities/Organizations, which are as follows:

**1. Wimborne Rotary Club-Shelter Box Appeal...**Shelter Boxes provide on a worldwide basis humanitarian relief and aid in the form of material and equipment that provides shelter, warmth and comfort to people displaced by natural and other disasters. Each box provides shelter and warmth for up to ten people for a prolonged period and contains a large high quality tent, plus blankets and other survival essentials. Boxes cost £490 each.

Supporting the Scouts in their Centenary Year 2007,

**2. 1<sup>st</sup> Wimborne Scouts...**celebrate their own centenary in 2010 and money raised will be used to start their centenary fund.

**3. 2<sup>nd</sup> Wimborne Scouts...** have a project to improve the acoustics at their headquarters. Insulation Boards will be fitted round the inside of the building at a cost of £5000, so I hope we can help a little towards the project. As a special too in this centenary year I have appointed two Mayors' Scouts one from each Troop.

**4. Wimborne in Bloom...**run completely by volunteers and needs to raise over £13,000 each year to fund its operation of providing and maintaining plants, planters and hanging baskets throughout the town centre. Judging in the Regional South and South East in Bloom Competition takes place this year on a date yet to be announced during the fortnight commencing Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June. Please help us to keep the Town looking its very best throughout the summer.
